Are you up-to-date? We can help!

Reminder that children age 4-6 need to have boosters before attending school in the fall! Also, all children entering 7th grade, or at least age 11, are due for a tetanus and meningitis booster. Adults should receive a tetanus booster every 10 years or in the third trimester of each pregnancy.

How much does the program cost? Plain Healthy Program fees until May 1st:

Fee	Service	Service Description
\$10.00	Household Convenience Fee	Applies one time to each bill, not each child
\$50.00	Well Child Check	Full examination by a Clinician
\$20.00	Immunizations	Administration of immunizations by a Medical Assistant/Nurse
\$5.00	Consult	Brief exam and discussion with a Clinician
\$100.00	Sick Visit	Full examination of acutely ill patient with intervention
\$25.00	Single Cerumen Impaction Removal	Removal of cerumen from one ear
\$35.00	Bilateral Cerumen Impaction Removal	Removal of cerumen from both ears
\$15.00	Urinalysis	Screening urinalysis on site
\$15.00	Rapid Strep Test	Screening for strep infection on site
\$169.00	Chiropractic Care Consult	Initial consult, plus additional \$57 for 1-2 regions; \$60.00 for 3-4 regions; or \$87.00 for 5 or more regions
\$0.00	Fluoride Varnish	Professionally applied fluoride varnish by a Clinician
-\$5.00	Multiplicity Discount	Discount per additional child, limit \$20 discount

Starting May 1st, 2025, our Plain Healthy Program fees are changing to make the program more convenient for families and more efficient & sustainable for Union Community Care:

- A flat fee of \$60 will be applied to the first family member seen in the household.
- A flat fee of \$40 fee will be applied to each additional family member seen in the household.

Medications with 340B Pricing

The Plain Healthy Program includes medications with 340B pricing, which means medications are more affordable for those who need it. Medications with 340B pricing include amoxicillin, suspension, fluoride tablets, debrox, ophthalmic drops, otic drops, Silvadene, nystatin, and Aquaphor ointment. Other medications may be added depending on need.
